Division Structure

ATP Practice Area Divisions are led by an elected leadership team comprised of a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary. The Chair of the Division attends ATP Board of Directors meetings as a representative of the Division. All Regular members of ATP are invited to vote and hold office at the Division level. All Associate members and Subscribers are invited to participate in Divisional activities and meetings. All Divisions meet once a year at the *Innovations in Testing Conference*. Divisions may hold additional meetings for ATP members at industry related conferences.

Certification/Licensure
