This year, ATP proudly hosted the 2026 Innovations in Testing Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana. With strong attendance and a diverse, engaged audience, the conference reflected the continued momentum and vibrancy of our community. Our theme, “Celebrating People, Progress, and Possibilities,” highlighted the individuals, innovations, and ideas shaping the future of assessment. The program featured dynamic, forward-thinking sessions alongside new experiential elements, including the introduction of the Discovery Zone, which was first debuted at E-ATP. We also introduced attendee favorites like the Puppy Break and Beignet Café, which added moments of connection, energy, and local flavor to the conference experience.

In Europe, the 2025 E-ATP Conference in Dublin brought together assessment professionals from around the world for three inspiring days of learning, collaboration, and innovation. With more than a 25% increase in attendance, the event reflected strong and growing engagement across the global assessment community. Notably, 80% of attendees joined from outside the U.S., with 50% representing the EU and UK, and participants spanning 29 different countries, underscoring the conference’s truly international reach. As one of the most successful E-ATP gatherings to date, Dublin demonstrated the strength of ATP’s European footprint and the continued demand for meaningful global connection and exchange. We now look ahead with great excitement to the 2026 E-ATP Conference, taking place for the first time in Rome, Italy, from 7–9 October, where we will continue building on this momentum.

ATP also kicked off the year with the 2026 I-ATP Conference in New Delhi this January, which saw record attendance and featured an outstanding program. The event brought together an influential group of professionals and highlighted the region’s energy and engagement, further strengthening ATP’s global presence. We are committed to continuing to build on this momentum and support the growth of our India Regional Division.

Now in its fourth year, the ATP Learning Academy continues to grow as a cornerstone of our educational mission. Building on the success of our Introduction to Assessment Literacy course, we are actively developing new courses to meet the evolving needs of our members. We also look forward to launching these offerings alongside a new learning platform later this year, further strengthening ATP’s commitment to accessible, high-quality professional development.

As the assessment landscape continues to evolve, ATP has expanded its focus on delivering timely, relevant resources that support our members in navigating change. Through a growing portfolio of coffee chats, webinars, publications, and guidance materials, we are creating more opportunities for learning, dialogue, and practical insight across key areas impacting the industry.

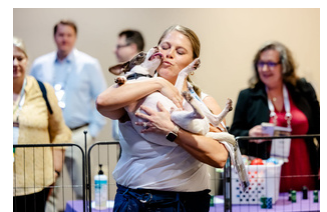
