Membership Categories

Regular Membership - Organizational

Regular Members can be any individual, company or organization that develops, validates, markets, sells, scores, interprets and/or provides tests and/or assessment tools with psychometric properties or services related to assessment for clinical, occupational, certification, licensure, educational or similar uses. **All Regular Members must have at least one professional, qualified in testing and assessment, on staff or under contract, who holds at least a doctorate in psychology or measurement, or substantially equivalent experience and/or expertise deemed satisfactory in the judgment of the Board of Directors.** Regular Members have access to all areas of the ATP website. They receive group discounts on conference sponsorship and registrations. Regular Members have voting privileges and may serve on the Board, Divisions and Committees.

Associate Membership - Organizational

Associate Members are any individual, company or organization that does not meet the definition or qualifications for Regular Membership or that sells to or buys from the testing and assessment industry. Associate Members have access to all areas of the ATP website. They receive group discounts on conference sponsorship and registrations. Associate Members may be active in Divisions and Committees, **but do not vote or hold office.**

Subscriber Membership - Individual

Subscribers are **individual** members. They receive member discounts on conference registrations and publications, They have access to all areas of the ATP website. Subscribers may be active in Divisions and Committees, **but do not vote or hold office.**
